 - HIST 2010 (U.S. History to 1877) and HIST 2020 (U.S. History since 1877)
 - ENGL2530 (Survey of English Literature I) and ENGL2540 (Survey of English Literature II)
 - ENGL2570 (Survey of American Literature I) and ENGL2580 (Survey of American Literature II)
 - ENGL2600 (Survey of Literature of the Western World I) and ENGL2610 (Survey of Literature of the Western World)
