  - ENGL2530 (Survey of English Literature I) and ENGL2540(Survey of English Literature II)
  - ENGL2570 (Survey of American Literature I) and ENGL2580 (Survey of American Literature II)
  - ENGL2600(Survey of Literature of the Western World I) and ENGL2610(Survey of Literature of the Western World)
